Communicating with pupils and other participants of the education process, recognising upcoming problems, analysis of their solutions; creating a positive pedagogic interaction and maintaining it; analysing the forms and ways to communicate with parents; strengthening skills of creating a preventative work plan for an institution; participation in practical tasks along with a social pedagogue, joining correctional activities with at-risk children and

social pedagogue's consultation activity.

Pedagogic practice with the help of a mentor - strengthening skills of creating a preventative work plan for an institution; participation in practical tasks along with a social pedagogue, joining correctional activities with at-risk children and their families; reflecting on the importance of a social pedagogue's consultation activity.

Independent social pedagogue's practice — improving students' practical skills on establishing and solving pupils' social, educational, behavioural, and personal contact problems; prompting initiative, creativity and innovation implementation through independent work with pupils, while providing pedagogical-social support and striving to achieve a non-formal leader's position.
